Winter Campaign impact 2023|24

Plus Dane's 2023 24 Winter Campaign was really successful, it was aimed at customers and households in need, those who were most affected by the cost-of-living crisis as well as the added pressures of winter and the festive period.

We used our data insight to make sure we focused our resources in the right areas and more importantly, for the right customers. We targeted two customer cohorts.

- 1 customers living in homes at risk of been cold with low EPC ratings along with vulnerabilities.
- 2 customers with long term health conditions who were identified as part of the damp and mould task force group.

1505 texts were sent to these customers, asking them to get in touch if they were worried about the winter and festive period.

Customer facing teams from across the organisation were briefed on the Winter Campaign objectives and were asked to identify vulnerable customers in need and to refer them via the One Referral route.

St Columba's Pantry

Set up in April the St Columba's Pantry has over 140 members - over half of which are Plus Dane customers. Funded by an anonymous benefactor via LFC and staffed by volunteers, the project has been a great example of partnership working between St Andrews Community Network, Plus Dane, LFC and St Columba's Church. Members can select their own food including fresh fruit and vegetables for £3.50 fee each week.

Other partners attend to offer support on a rota basis including Plus Dane Housing Officer, repairs and welfare staff, BNENC Welfare Rights Advisor, Transform Lives, NHS - health advice and support and Liverpool in Work. Plus Dane also works with Brick by Brick who provide household items every month such as toiletries, blankets, toys, and other items that make a home. These are supplied free via Amazon and would usually go to landfill rather than be re-shelved.
