4 of you said you would like to volunteer at the hub	The Bromley Farm residents' group will invite you to the Bromley Farm Wellbeing Hub and make you aware of any volunteering opportunities	Nov 2024
50% of you wanted cooking classes & help with cooking on a budget	The current cooking provision at the hub ends on the 17 th October. We are working with a local partner to start a new cooking course in January and will contact everyone who expressed an interested & promote on social media	Jan 2024
41% of you wanted a youth club for younger children after school	Youth club activities are already taking place at the Bromley Farm Community Centre. We encourage residents to contact the centre directly for further details	
36% of you want a lunch club for older people on the estate	This provision already takes place every Tuesday. Older residents are welcome to attend the Luncheon club from 1pm at the Bromley Farm Wellbeing Hub . We will promote on social media to help raise awareness and post leaflets	Jan 2024
