

Freeholder Resale

- what happens

When a Freeholder wishes to sell their home the following steps will be taken:

- Plus Dane will provide the Freeholder with details of what will happen next and let them know what our fees are
- The Freeholder will confirm their solicitors details to Plus Dane, including contact information
- If the Freeholder wishes to advertise the home on Plus Dane's website they should pass the estate agent's marketing information to Plus Dane with a link to the estate agent's website. Plus Dane is not able to advertise any homes for sale which are not being marketed through an estate agent
- When a buyer has been found, the estate agent or Freeholder should notify Plus Dane
- The Freeholder and prospective buyer will instruct their respective solicitors
- Plus Dane will provide Management Pack (FME1) to the solicitor once payment has been received

Once both solicitors have been instructed they will communicate with each other until the transaction is complete.

There may be instances where there are delays in the transaction, at this point the Freeholder or Plus Dane can speak to one another to understand the cause of the delay and see how best to move forward, however, the main point of contact throughout the transaction is your solicitor.
